Information Sheet

Format:

- **70m Qualification Round** (72 arrows) for Seniors and Juniors
- **60m Qualification Round** (72 arrows) for Cadets
- **Championship Rounds** - Individual Elimination Rounds at 70m for Seniors and Juniors using the Set System per FITA rules. Cadets are not eligible for individual elimination rounds.
- **Open Team Rounds** at 70m for Seniors and Juniors.
- **Novelty Shoot** at 60m for Cadets. Format and schedule t.b.d.

The **SoCal Showdown** is open to all Senior, Junior and Cadet - Recurve and Compound Archers who are members of NAA, NFAA or an international FITA member organization. Please be prepared to show your ID card, or purchase a new membership. This is a USAT and Jr.USAT Qualifying Event, Star FITA, authorized CAP event. All 70m archers will be ranked together for Team and Elimination rounds. The highest possible cuts for the OR Round will be applied in each division (up to 64). Cadets are not eligible for cash awards.

Fees:

- **\$125 per Senior/Junior**
- **\$75 per Cadet**
- **\$35 late fee** if received after September 20, 2010 but prior to the application deadline of October 1, 2010. There will be no on-the-field registration.
- **\$30 per Team for Open Team Rounds**, payable at Check-in.

Medals will be awarded for the 1st, 2nd and 3rd places for Male Recurve, Female Recurve, Male Compound and Female Compound in the following divisions:

CAP Division
Junior Division
Cadet Division

•Championship Rounds (70m):

Cash prizes will be awarded to 1st - 4th place Individuals in the Elimination Rounds in:

All 70m archers will be combined for Championship Rounds.

Sign-ups will be open at the Check-In Table until Saturday morning at 8:30 a.m.

Team event fees are payable at Check-in.

The highest ranked 16 teams in each division will compete for prizes.

Fees will be refunded to any team that does not qualify.

Event Schedule:

- Friday, October 8 - Check-in and Open Practice - Gate opens at 11 a.m.
- Saturday, October 9 - Ranking Rounds and Open Team Rounds - Gate opens at 7 a.m.
- Sunday, October 10 - Championship Rounds and Awards - Gate opens at 7 a.m.

Dress Code: USA Archery/NAA Dress Code and FITA rules, will be strictly enforced. All archers must wear appropriate footwear including sport shoes covering the foot. (FITA, Book 1, 3.22.1.2) Note that sport sandals are not acceptable.

Food and Beverage Concessions: There will be food available on site at all times during the tournament. Water will be provided for archers only. Additional information will be available on www.roadrunnerarchery.com as it becomes available.

Shade and Seating:

- Shade canopies and seating will be provided for the archers.
- Some shade and bleacher seating will be available for spectators.
- Spectators are encouraged to bring their own shade canopies and seating.

Transportation and Lodging: San Diego International Airport (SAN) is located approximately 30 minutes (24 miles) from the tournament location. Detailed Hotel info will be posted on www.roadrunnerarchery.com as it becomes available.

Cancellations: There will be no refunds for cancellations made after October 1, 2010. Email notification of cancellation is acceptable.

2010 FITA Rules: Please visit www.archery.org to review these new 2010 rules. A 'Rules Summary' will be posted on www.roadrunnerarchery.com .

Waivers: All archers must sign a liability and photo waiver prior to participating in tournament activities. The Chula Vista Olympic Training Center also has waivers that must be signed at or before check-in. Archers under 18 years of age must also have a parent or legal guardian sign all waivers.

Coaches: Personal coaches must stay behind the spectator line during scoring. Personal coaches are allowed up to the waiting line during practice. During Elimination Matches, personal coaches are allowed up to the waiting line during practice and during scoring and may be in the archer's tents. No more than one coach per archer may be at the waiting line during elimination matches. Seating is reserved for archers.

Agents: Credentialed persons assisting AR archers may sit in the archer's tents.

Photographers: Must be credentialed (max. of 4) by the tournament to be allowed at the waiting line/photo lane, in blinds or down range.

USAT and Junior USAT Qualifier: USAT requirements/ranking information may be found at <http://archery.teamusa.org/> .

Drug Testing: Any archer may be subject to unannounced drug testing. Refusal to test may lead to disqualification. Information may be requested from USADA.
